

The Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake Footage Archive Project New Global Website (English) Now Online!

This year marks the 27th anniversary of the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake (January 17, 1995). As part of its CSR activities, on January 6, Asahi Broadcasting Group Holdings Corporation (Fukushima-ku, Osaka, Japan; Susumu Okinaka, representative director and president) launched a global version (English) of its Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake Footage Archive website.

The company makes group historical disaster-related footage available for the public as a means to prevent and mitigate future disasters.

The company is confident that the new global website will provide more opportunities for foreign nationals living in Japan, various organizations, educational institutions, and the international community at large to learn about disaster prevention and mitigation.

The company intends to post information to a website operated by the United Nations Disaster Reduction Agency (UNDRR) that publishes disaster reduction actions around the world (<https://sendaicommitments.undrr.org>).
